



## 2025 911 Memorial Scholarship Recipients

The 911 memorial scholarship fund was established in remembrance of Jennifer Wong and Susan Huie who we lost during this tragic September 11<sup>th</sup> event. The Church Board selects annual awards to candidates who are either in seminary studies, in Christian ministry services, or in Christian missionary work. This year, the Church Board awarded the scholarships to twelve recipients in the amount of \$1,000 each.

**ANGELA** is serving in Hong Kong and partners with Young Life and Safe Families to reach out to young single moms.

**DENNIS & EVANGELINE CHOW** have been serving in the Philippines for the past 9 years. They have worked at Faith Academy, ministering to the children of missionaries.

**YCK & GK** serve in southeast Asia with Pioneers to do church planting work among two unreached people groups (UPG). He and his wife work with a team of national workers (Rainbow of Hope), run a language school and mobilize new missionaries to the other 50+ UPG on the island.

**BEVAN GREINER** is the Director of Family Christian Inspiration Inc. The Greiner family shares Christ through a ministry of music, gospel-ventriloquism and Bible-based preaching.

**PASTOR MANKIN FAN** established the San Francisco Bay Area Short Term Mission Team (BASTM) and its Board of Directors. He has served in Christian Short-Term Mission Training Centers in New York, Chicago and San Francisco.

**JUSTIN GUAMAN** is an Intervarsity Campus Fellowship (IVCF) staff worker serving in Queens. He organizes strategic programs to engage with students in Queens, with a primary focus on York College.

**PASTOR PAUL GUO** is on staff with Chinese Christian Herald Crusades (CCHC). He and his wife planned and organized all aspects of the summer school program and visit with churches and engage in their activities.

**QIU YAN PATRICIA HUANG-LUO** is currently a full-time Bible college student.

**YONG QI LUO**, upon receiving God's grace in his life, closed his business in August 2025 to attend seminary full-time.

**CASEY LIU** is currently serving as a Chinese Outreach Ministries (COM) staff member at the University of Central Florida Campus. COM shares the gospel with Chinese students and staff at American universities.
